MEMORIAL DAY PARADE

Please join Keego Harbor in its traditional Memorial Day Parade Monday, May 29th, 2017. The one mile parade will begin at Abbott Middle School on Orchard Lake Rd, continuing East and then North on Cass Lake Rd, concluding at Keego Harbor's City Hall. Buses will be available

at the conclusion of the parade to take participants back to their cars at Abbott.

Prior to the parade, there will be a ceremony at 9:30am in Veterans Memorial Plaza (the "Rock") honoring those who gave the ultimate sacrifice for our country, as well as past and present members of the United States Armed Forces.

Parade participants are asked to check in by 9:15 AM the morning of the parade. Large groups are asked to carpool to the staging area off Commerce Road behind the school. The parade will start promptly at 10:00 AM. Staging information will be provided to the contact person of each group one week prior to the parade. It's important that all information be shared with individual participants in your group.

Parade Marshals will be onsite at Abbott School to assist. We anticipate a large viewing audience along the parade route. The parade will be televised live to Channel 20,000 homes and broadcast

on Cable TV (Comcast 15).

Fox 2 News Sports Reporter and Keego Harbor resident Woodruffe will once again team up with Eri Gubka as they narrate the parade from their location in front of the Roosevelt School for the viewing audience.
