 - Watashi no denwa bango wa desu (my phone number is--- in numbers)
 - Anata no jusho wa nandesuka? (what is your address)
 - Watashi no Jusho wa (my address is --- give numbers and street name)
 - Ano sumimasen. (Ah, excuse me.)
 - Tasukete kudasai, michi ni mayoi mashita (help, I am lost)
 - Tasukete kudasai. (Help me, please. - can also be used when you're in danger.)
 - Nihongo o hotondo hanasemasen. (I can hardly speak Japanese.)
 - Japanese for telephone number is denwa bangoo
 - 0=zero = ゼロ
 - 1= Ichi = いち
 - 2= Ni = に
 - 3= San = さん
 - 4=Yon = よん
 - 5=Go = ご
 - 6=Roku = ろく
 - 7=Nana = なな
 - 8=Hachi = はち
 - 9=Kyu = きゅう

■ 10=Juu = じゅう
