 - Boku wa kudamono ga tabetai desu (I want to eat fruit).
 - Watashi wa Nihon shoku ga tabetai desu (I want to eat Japanese food)
 - Boku wa hamburger ga tabetai desu (I want to eat a hamburger).
 - Watashi wa okashi ga tabetai desu (I want to eat a sweet)
 - Boku wa sushi ga tabetai desu (I want to eat sushi).
 - Watashi wa yogurt ga tabetai desu (I want to eat yogurt)
 - Boku wa spaghetti ga tabetai desu (I want to eat spaghetti).
 - Watashi wa pizza ga tabetai desu (I want to eat pizza)
 - Boku wa cake ga tabetai desu (I want to eat cake).
